



## THE RED LION INN

Stockbridge, Massachusetts

Established c. 1773, and rebuilt in 1897, The Red Lion Inn is one of the few remaining American Inns in continuous use since the 18<sup>th</sup> century. Immortalized in Norman Rockwell's painting *Stockbridge Main Street at Christmas*, the Inn epitomizes New England hospitality. The Red Lion Inn has hosted five presidents as well as Nathaniel Hawthorne, William Cullen Bryant, Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, John Wayne, Bob Dylan and others. The Red Lion Inn is a proud charter member of Historic Hotels of America and The Original Historic Inns of New England.

The Red Lion Inn is at the center of the Berkshires' historic and cultural attractions and is minutes away from skiing, Tanglewood, The Berkshire Theatre Festival, The Norman Rockwell Museum, Chesterwood, Naumkeag, Jacob's Pillow and Hancock Shaker Village.

The Inn comprises: 108 guest rooms (including 25 suites) throughout the Main Inn and seven nearby guest houses including the Firehouse. (Meadowlark, the former summer studio of Daniel Chester French, is also available in season.) Seven Meeting Rooms can accommodate up to 100 people for banquets, business, and social events. A fitness room, Massage Therapist, and heated outdoor pool are available. Golf and tennis are nearby.

Dining: The Red Lion Inn specializes in contemporary regional cuisine, served with gracious New England hospitality in authentic surroundings. Executive Chef Brian J. Alberg emphasizes natural flavors and the use of fresh, local ingredients in his cooking, and the inn's menus are revised to reflect the bounty of each changing season. Accompanying the menu is an award-winning wine list with more than 200 selections.

Guests can choose from the elegant Main Dining Room, the cozy Widow Bingham's Tavern, or the casual Lion's Den pub. In warm weather, the flower-laden courtyard is the ideal place to enjoy a cocktail, midday or late night snack, or a leisurely meal.
